The Nadur Local Council's allocation for the fiscal year of 2012 is €414,002. Besides the financial allocation the council has financial commitments under the PPP scheme of €840,355. for resurfacing works that took place in 2011. The council has also financial commitments from Urban Improvement Funds. Besides these the council has funds under the Cultural funds scheme in the amount of €5,500. The council is also budgeting for funds under the special needs allocation, sports activities scheme and others.

This year's budget includes the payment of roads resurfaced under the PPP Scheme. The council managed to resurface 10 streets under this scheme. This scheme rejuvenated a whole area of the locality. The council is also planning to redo the street lighting at December 13th Street through Urban Improvement Funds (UIF). This will be second part of the embellishment of December 13th Street, following the resurfacing of the same street during 2011. The council has also
